A new Landscape Architecture Registration law was signed by the Illinois Governor on August 6, 2021. As a result, the use of the title “registered landscape architect” and other iterations are once again protected under the new Statute and regulated by official registration issued by the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation (Department).

As part of the new law, a “grandfather” provision was added to enable the Department to issue a new registration - without fee - for those who were actively registered with the Department prior to January 1, 2020, when the profession was previously de-regulated in Illinois.

You are receiving this notice as Department records indicate that you held an active registration on the specified date and may qualify for the new registration under the grandfather provision.

The Rules for the Administration of the Act are currently under legislative review, and once adopted, you should receive a separate email with instructions on how to obtain/renew your Illinois registration.
